# DETERMINATION NO. 150 OF 1993

#### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 40A of the Dog Control Act 1975 empowers the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This determination amends Determination no 134 of 1993 which has been found to be faulty. This determination sets fees for:

registration of a dog, replacing a tag or certificate of registration, licence for keeping 4 or more dogs, licence for keeping a dangerous dog, return and transport of a dog impounded under the Act, providing a certified copy of a certificate of registration, viewing the register,

The fees are set out below, and fees applying in 1992/93 are shown in brackets.

The increases result from a review of charges, which are in line with Government's Budget strategy to keep increases in fees to a level which equate for Consumer Price Index. The increases also include measures to encourage the early sterilization of dogs, obedience training and early registration. Additional comments are included in the table below where necessary.

## Description of the matter in respect of which fee is payable

The fee for the registration of a dog, by a keeper not the benefit of a discounted fee, is:
