Summary

The Government Procurement Bill 2001 (the Bill) creates the Government Procurement Board, with responsibility for the ongoing improvement of procurement practices and purchasing skills in Government agencies.

These amendments expand the definition of Territory entity to include Administrative units, and replace the example of a signposted definition.

Details of the amendments

PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

Clause 3 Dictionary - the example of signposted definition 'Territory entity' has been replaced with 'responsible chief executive'.

DICTIONARY

The Dictionary is amended by expanding the definition of *Territory entity* to include administrative units.
