**DETERMINATION OF FEES**

**NO. 122 OF 1993**

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This instrument revokes Determination No. 116 of 1992 which was published in Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. 27 of 8 July 1992, and replaces it with a further Determination.

The new Determination sets fees for the purposes of the Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) Act 1984 and has the effect of increasing the ad valorem fees for the initial grant or renewal of petroleum wholesale (and where appropriate retail) licences that commence from 1 November 1993. The franchise fees are to increase in line with current New South Wales rates, being:

Diesel Fuel	7.08 cents per litre
Petroleum	7.04 cents per litre

All other fees set by the previous Determination, including those relating to tobacco franchise fees, remain unchanged.
