PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO. 20 OF 1993

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of Divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Under section 4 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, I revoke the street names as per attached in various divisions as the original street designs did not go ahead and these street names can be used in different locations at a later date.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, Land and Planning.

Schedule 'A' of the Determination, details the names origins and significance of a number of streets in various divisions.

Schedule 'B' of the Determination revokes a number of existing street names so they may be used in different locations at a later date.
