DETERMINATION OF FEES Defermination NO 26 of 1993

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This instrument revokes all existing fees determined under the Liquor Act 1975 in Determination No. 87 of 1992 as published in the Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No. S101 of 30 June 1992.

The determination sets fees for the purpose of the grant and transfer of a liquor licence and the fees for the purpose of a liquor permit application. The determination incorporates the new rates for liquor permit applications consistent with the liquor fees set pursuant to the Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993. The various fees which apply under the Liquor Act are set out below.
