## **PHARMACY ACT 1931**

### **DETERMINATION NO. 143 OF 1992**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Pharmacy Act 1931 provides for the registration of legally qualified practitioners, and for fees to be charged in respect to the granting of both initial and annual registration. Section 50 of the Act empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine fees in respect to paragraphs 24 (d) and 26 (1)(b) of the Act.

This instrument:

1. Revokes all existing fees and determinations under the Pharmacy Act 1931 which relates to paragraphs 24 (d) and 26 (1)(b) which provisions make the collection of fees for both initial and annual registrations; and
2. Sets fees for the purpose of the Act as they relate to:
