## AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY PUBLIC PLACES NAMES ACT 1989 DETERMINATION NO. 35 OF 1992

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Public Place Names Act 1989, provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

The Determination, together with accompanying maps, details the names of the public places which, by virtue of section 3 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, includes an avenue or a road, street or place which the public are entitled to use and nay unleased land.

Schedule A of the Determination shows the new plan layout of the affected streets within the Gordon 8 and Banks 2 Developments.

Schedule B of the Determination revokes the names of a number of streets in the Divisions of Gordon and Banks. Previously, non-standard identifiers were assigned and this gazettal now standardises these streets with all other Canberra Nomenclature.

Schedule C of the Determination varies the location of a street. The original street development did not go ahead and the name has been reused in a different location.
