**DETERMINATION OF FEES 1992**

No. 118 of 1992

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This instrument revokes all existing determinations under section 6B of the Scaffolding and Lifts Act 1957, namely

Determination notice dated 1 July 1991 published in Australian Capital Territory  
Gazette No. 49

This determination sets fees for the purposes of the Scaffolding and Lifts Act 1957 and also has the effect of exempting persons successfully completing a TAFE training course, from the gazetted fees for the examination, issue of learners permits and certificates of competency, where the Chief Inspector signs the certificate. There are fee increases of approximately 3% to that determined in Gazette No. 49. A new fee is established for the testing of lifts and a penalty incurred where a re-test is necessary due to its failure to meet standards. The threshold level for payment of notice of intention to build has been lifted to minimise impact on private housing and minor alterations; areas which rarely are serviced or where fees are attracted.. The fees are set out below with previous fees shown in brackets.
