EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Veterinary Surgeons Registration Act 1965 provides for the registration of legally qualified practitioners, and for fees to be charged in respect to the granting of both initial and annual registration. Section 42B of the Act empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine fees in respect to subsection 12(3) and paragraph 17(1)(b) of the Act.

This instrument:

- 1. Revokes all existing fees and determinations under the Veterinary Surgeons Registration Act 1965 which relate to subsection 12(3) and paragraph 17(1)(b) which provisions make the collection of fees for both initial and annual registrations; and
- 2. Sets fees for the purposes of the Act as they relate to:
