PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO.104 OF 1991

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary, Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

Schedule 'A' of the Determination, together with accompanying map, details the names of the public places which, by virtue of section 3 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, includes an avenue or a road, street or place which the public are entitled to use and any unleased land.

Furthermore Schedule 'A' also commemorates Alfred Mainwaring Rich as he established a private school in the Teagardens area of Ginninderra in 1881. Which is now situated within the Division of Palmerston and is considered to be of Historical significance in the Gungahlin District.
