## ROAD TRANSPORT (VEHICLE REGISTRATION) AES INSPECTION FEES DETERMINATION 2004 (NO 1)

### INSTRUMENT No. NI 2004 - 190

### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This determination sets the maximum fees payable to the proprietor of an authorised premises for inspecting or testing of motor vehicles or trailers, pursuant to Regulation 131 of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*. The proprietor of authorised premises may charge less than the determined fee. The arrangements for Government accredited private vehicle inspectors are known as the Authorised Examiner Scheme (AES).

The maximum fees are equal to the amount determined under Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* for inspections conducted by Government vehicle inspectors at the Dickson Vehicle Inspection Station.

The amounts have not changed since the last determination of this fee, instrument no. NI2003 – 199, dated 12 May 2003 and notified on the ACT Legislation Register on 10 June 2003. However, the format of the previous determination requires minor technical changes for consistency with other fee determinations made since the commencement of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
