BOOKMAKERS REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Bookmakers Act 1998* (the Act) provides for the licensing of bookmakers, to impose fees payable by bookmakers and for other purposes.

Section 56 of the Act empowers the Executive to make regulations for the purposes of the Act.

Clause 3 of the amendment amends the citation of the regulations from the "*Bookmakers Regulations*" to the "*Bookmakers Regulations 1985*".

Clauses 4 amends the heading of Regulation 5A to accord with the amendment at Clause 5.

Clause 5 removes the subregulation that prescribes the minimum amounts that can be bet by telephone with a bookmaker and removes a related definition.

Clause 6 allows the renumbering of the regulations, as a result of the amendments, when it is next reprinted.
