## Explanatory Statement

The objects of these Regulations are to provide some general administrative provisions in relation to the administration of the Road Transport legislation.

The regulations provide for:

- a) the keeping of and access to a database of declaration and orders (Regs 5&6);
- b) the Road Transport Authority to delegate the issue of parking permits under paragraph 100(2)(g) of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 to the Secretary of the Commonwealth Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (Reg 7);
- c) an identity card for a person authorised to serve infringement or reminder notices must show the person's unique number issued by the administering authority, and the person's name and signature (Reg 8);
- d) certificate evidence acceptable to a court in proceedings about authorised examiners and approved premises (Part 3);
- e) decisions under the road transport legislation which are subject to review and those that are not subject to internal review (Part 4 and Schedule 1);
- f) details regarding the provision of refunds, including a refund formula (Regs 12-14); and
- g) actions in relation to dishonoured payments (Regs 15-18).

These Regulations are made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*.
