SUPREME COURT RULES AMENDMENT

The resident Judges of the Court (of whom there are currently four, including the Chief Justice) or any two of the resident Judges, may make Rules of Court for regulating the practice and procedure of the Court pursuant to Section 36 of the *Supreme Court Act* 1933.

These rules amend the Supreme Court Rules and commence 28 days after they are notified in the Gazette.

The rules regulate the handling and return of documents and things which might be admitted as exhibits or produced to the Court in answer to a subpoena.
