#### **SUBORDINATE LAW No SL 2004-29**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Road Transport (Offences) Amendment Regulations 2004 (No 2) amend the Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001.

Section 54(1)(c) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* provides that the authority's function may be delegated to an authorised person. It is not necessary for a delegated person to also be an authorised person. Section 54(1)(b) provides that the Administering Authority may delegate the authority's functions to a person prescribed under the regulations. New regulation 14A provides that a public employee is a person to whom the authority's functions may be delegated.
