ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES REGULATIONS

Outline.

The Roads and Public Places Act 1937 empowers the Minister to grant a permit to place an object in a public place on payment of a prescribed fee.

The Roads and Public Places Regulations (hereafter the Regulations) will prescribe the fees to be charged in respect of applications to place an object in an area of public land.

Detail.

Regulations 1 and 2

Regulations 1 and 2 identify the title of the Regulations and specify that the Regulation will commence on notification in the Gazette.

Regulation 3

Regulation 3 repeals a regulation made in 1983. This regulation is now redundant.

Regulation 4

Regulation 4 is an interpretive provision.

Regulation 5

Regulation 5 specifies a formula that will be applied to calculate the fee to be paid for the grant of a permit under section 15E of the Roads and Public Places Act 1937 or for the renewal of a permit under section 15K of that Act. The formula will have regard to the area of land that will be used and whether the area is covered or uncovered.
