## **LIQUOR REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)**

**Subordinate Law No. 60 of 1997**

### **PURPOSE**

The intention of the amendment is to extend the trading hours during which liquor can be sold for consumption on licensed premises for Anzac Day 25 April 1997.

### **BACKGROUND**

Representations have been received requesting the removal of the restriction on trading hours to enable traditional Anzac Day morning celebrations to be conducted at licensed premises in the ACT.

### **DETAILS OF THE AMENDMENT**

For 25 April 1997 regulation 3A is amended to allow the sale of liquor for consumption on licensed premises between the hours of 4.00am and 7.00am by omitting subregulation (1) and paragraph (3)(a).
