# DISCRIMINATION (REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

### **OUTLINE**

These regulations set the remuneration for the Discrimination Commissioner appointed under the Discrimination Act 1991.

### NOTES ON REGULATIONS

Regulation 1 says the Regulations may be cited as the Discrimination (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations.

Regulation 2 says that "the Act" means the Discrimination Act 1991.

**Regulation 3** sets the Commissioner's remuneration at \$366.00 for each day where he or she is engaged in holding public hearings for three hours or more. An hourly rate of \$122.00 is provided to calculate remuneration when the Commissioner is engaged in holding public hearings for periods of less than three hours on a day.

**Regulation 4** provides that the Commissioner shall be paid an allowance of \$5,000 per year.

**Regulation 5** provides for a travelling allowance for travel outside the ACT at the rate of \$300.00 per day in a capital city and \$155.00 per day in any other case. The allowance does not include the cost of conveyance.
