HERITAGE COUNCIL (REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS

GENERAL OUTLINE

Part III of the <u>Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991</u> (the Land Act) establishes the ACT Heritage Council and subsection 102A(1) specifies that members of the Council are to be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed. The Heritage Council (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations specifies the rate at which the Chairperson and members of the Council are to be paid.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of the Council will be approximately \$25,000 for a full financiual year.

NOTES ON REGULATIONS

Regulation 1 provides that these Regulations may be cited as the Heritage Council (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations.

Regulation 2 specifies the rate of remuneration and allowances that are to be paid to appointed members of the Heritage Council.

Subregulation 2(1) provides that the Chairperson of the Heritage Council shall be paid the remuneration and allowances that are payable to a part-time holder of a public office that is determined to be a Category 2 Office of Chairperson within the meaning of Determination No 5 of 1992 of the Remuneration Tribunal of the Commonwealth.

Subregulation 2(2) provides that other members of the Heritage Council shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are payable to a part-time holder of a public office, not being the office of Chairperson, that is a Category 2 Office within the meaning of Determination No 5 of 1992 of the Remuneration Tribunal of the Commonwealth.
