EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

BAIL REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) NO. 43 OF 1994

Section 58 of the *Bail Act 1992* provides that the Executive may make Regulations for the purposes of the Act.

The Bail (Amendment) Act No 73 of 1994 provides, *inter alia*, for section 57A to be inserted in the Bail Act. This section specifies a process for authorising forms and covers a wider range of forms than that previously contained in the Regulations. When the section commences, forms are to be approved by the Minister, published in the Gazette, and will be disallowable instruments for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.

As a consequence of these amendments, the Bail Regulations (Amendment) repeals two regulations which dealt with forms.

The substantive parts of these Regulations commence when section 21 of the Bail (Amendment) Act 1994 commences.
