Road Transport (Offences) (Declaration of Holiday Period) Determination 2004 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2004–258

Made under the

Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001, subsection 21(1)(e) Meaning of holiday period.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2001, subsection 21(1)(e), provide for the Minister to declare a period to be a holiday period. The declaration, by virtue of subsection 21(4), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 9 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

This instrument specifies the period from the first moment of Friday 24 December 2004 to the last moment of Monday 3 January 2005 (inclusive) to be a holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points, as specified in subsection 20(2) of the Regulation, will apply.

The declaration will link the Christmas holiday period for December 2004 with the New Year holiday period for January 2005, which will be consistent with the double demerit period in NSW.
