EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Outline

These regulations make an amendment to the Schedule 1 of the *Domestic Animals Regulations 2001*. That Schedule sets out the list of offences under the Domestic Animals Act 2000 that can be proceeded with by way of infringement notice.

Formal Clauses

Clause 1 contains the name of the regulations

Clause 2 is a formal requirement dealing with the commencement of the regulations. They are to commence when they are notified.

Clause 3 states that these regulations amend the *Domestic Animals Regulations* 2001.

Clause 4 makes the amendment to the Schedule. It adds the offence under section 41(4) of the Act, which is the offence of taking a dog into a prohibited area.

Clause 5 provides for renumbering of the Schedule on the next republication of the Regulations.
