

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

PUBLIC HEALTH (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) REGULATIONS

1989 No. 4

The Public Health (Miscellaneous Amendments) (the Amending Regulations) amend various Regulations made pursuant to the Public Health Ordinance. The Regulations so amended are:- Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations, Public Health (Boarding-houses) Regulations; Public Health (Dairy) Regulations; Public Health (Eating-houses) Regulations; Public Health (Meat) Regulations; Public Health (Piggeries) Regulations.

The amending Regulations simplify the method of enabling fees to be set by determination instead of by Regulations. These fees consist of various fees payable to the Australian Capital Territory Community and Health Service, for the issuing of licences under the above Public Health Regulations.

The amending Regulations amend the Regulations specified in the Schedule. The Schedule amends the Regulations by inserting the feminine form of words after the masculine form.
