Explanatory Statement

Outline

The ACT bushfire council has the function of advising the Emergency Services Authority and the Minister about matters relating to bushfires.

Under section 129 (1) of the *Emergencies Act 2004* the Minister must appoint the bushfire council members. Under s129 (2) the minister must try to ensure that people with particular skills, interests and experience are among the members appointed. The appointments are made according to these requirements.

The provisions of division 19.3.3 of the *Legislation Act 2001* are used for the appointment.

There are no public servants included on this instrument, as they are exempt from the above division by subsection 227(2) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

The Standing Committee of Legal Affairs has been consulted as required under the provisions of the *Legislation Act 2001*. The Committee advised that it had no concerns with the appointments.
