Explanatory Memorandum

Outline

The purpose of the Statute Law Revision (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill (No.2) 1992 ("the Bill") is to make various technical amendments and corrections to a range of Acts and repeal redundant Acts and provisions.

Schedule 1 of the Bill sets out the amendments which are made to a number of Acts, including the amendments to four Acts, consequential upon the provisions of the proposed Adoption Bill 1992.

As the Adoption Bill 1992 will not be considered by the Assembly until 1993, the consequential amendments relating to that Bill, included in the Statute Law Revision Bill require removal.

Amendments to Schedule 1

1.

The reference to the *Artificial Conception Act 1985* and the amendment to that Act are removed from the Bill.

2.

The reference to the *Birth (Equality of Status) Act 1988* and the amendment to that Act are removed from the Bill.

3.

The amendment to the definition of the term "adopting parent" in the *Children's Services Act 1986* is removed from the Bill.

4.

The reference to the *Testamentary Guardianship Act 1984* and the amendment to that Act are removed from the Bill.
