CHILDREN'S SERVICES (AMENDMENT) BILL 1991

I. Outline: This Bill amends the Children's Service Act 1986 to record the name change of the existing Youth Advocate to Community Advocate on the commencement of the Community Advocate Act 1991. There is no change to the existing youth advocacy functions.

2. Financial Considerations: There are no financial consideration involved.

CLAUSES OF THE BILL

Clause 1: Short title

This Act may be cited as the Children's Services (Amendment) Act 1991.

Clause 2: Commencement

This clause provides that the change in name of the Youth Advocate to Community Advocate commences on the same day as the Community Advocate is appointed under the Community Advocate Act 1991.

Clause 3: Principal Act

This clause identifies the Principal Act to be amended as the Children's Services Act 1986.

Clause 4: Repeal

This clause repeals the office of Youth Advocate as specified by section 9 of the Principal Act.

Clause 5: Acting appointments

This clause removes from the Principal Act references to acting appointments of a Youth Advocate (the Community Advocate Act 1991 contains its own provisions for acting appointments).

Clause 6: Community Advocate

This clause provides an ambulatory amendment which substitutes for all references to "Youth Advocate" in the Principal Act, the title "Community Advocate".

Clause 7: Transitional provisions

This clause preserves the validity of any instrument, act or thing done by the Youth Advocate prior to the change in title to Community Advocate.
