Road Transport (General) (Driver Licence and Related Fees) Determination 2005 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2005–82

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows for the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT Road Transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for driver licences and transactions relating to driver licences issued under the *Road Transport Legislation*.

All fees have been increased by CPI, rounded down to the nearest \$1.00 for amounts over \$100 and the nearest multiple of 50c for amounts below \$100. The exception is the fee for a provisional licence, which is calculated as exactly three fifths of a full five-year licence fee.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
