EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Overview

Regulation 75A (2) of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority who may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport Authority guidelines.

The Canberra International Airport has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority within the area of Canberra International Airport in the district of Majura.

Detail

The object of this instrument is for the Road Transport Authority to declare Canberra International Airport as a Parking Authority, which enables the organisation to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme within its boundaries.
