Road Transport (General) (Parking Permit Fees) Determination 2005 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2005–101

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows for the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT Road Transport legislation.

This Disallowable Instrument sets the fees for various kinds of parking permits. The fees in the determination have been increased by CPI, rounded down to the nearest dollar for amounts over \$100 and the nearest multiple of 50c for amounts below \$100. The fee structure is contained in Schedule 1, Column 4 of the Disallowable Instrument.

These new fees apply from 1 July 2005. The previous 2004/05 permit fees are shown in Schedule 1, Column 3 of this Disallowable Instrument.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within six sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
