LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) BILL (NO. 2) 1990

SUPPLEMENTARY EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) BILL (NO. 2) 1990

The first amendment alters paragraph 20(b) to rectify an omission from the Liquor (Amendment) Bill (No. 1) 1990. The requirement for the payment of a determined fee on the transfer of a licence re-enacts section 97 of the Liquor Act: that section is now repealed.

Amendments 2, 3 and 4 amend clauses 25, 26 and 27 respectively to take account of Government amendments to the Liquor (Amendment) Bill (No. 1) 1990 conferring power on the ACT Gaming and Liquor Authority to issue reprimands.

Amendment 5 corrects a typographical error in paragraph 27(f).

Amendment 6 brings proposed new paragraph 60(b) in clause 34 into line with similar provisions elsewhere in the Bill.

Amendments 7 to 13 are consequential upon the inclusion in the Liquor (Amendment) Bill (No. 1) 1990 of provision for the issue of reprimands, as described above.
