## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The *Nature Conservation Act 1980* provides for protection and conservation of native animals and native plants, and for the management of reserved areas.

Section 139 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2004—110 that set fees for the 2004-2005 financial year and to determine fees for the 2005-2006 financial year.

All fees have increased by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 2.5%.

The fees take effect the day after notification of the determination.

The determination under section 139 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
