EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Environment Protection Act 1997* is an Act to provide for the protection of the environment, and for related purposes.

Section 165 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2004–115 that set fees for the 2004-2005 financial year and to determine fees for the 2005-2006 financial year.

All fees have increased by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 2.5%.

The fees take effect after the day of notification of the determination.

The determination under section 165 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
