EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Animal Diseases Act 2005* is an Act to provide for the control of endemic and exotic diseases of animals and for other purposes.

Section 38 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to declare stock to be tagable stock.

The purpose of this declaration is to declare animals to be tagable stock for stock matters that are covered by the *Animal Diseases Act 2005*.

This instrument is the first declaration of tagable stock under the *Animal Diseases Act 2005*.

The determination under section 38 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
