Public Place Names Act 1989— section 3 (Minister to determine names)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, published in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to Section 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

Section 46 of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that power given under an Act to make an instrument includes the power to amend or repeal the instrument.

This Instrument **amends** the notice in Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No. P25 of 31 August 1988 (schedule on page 21 and the plan on page 52) by **revoking** the name *Wilbow Street* in the division of Phillip.

The road reserves known as Wilbow Street, Cavanough Street and Easty Street within Sections 81, 108, 131, 156, 157 and 158 have been closed. Wilbow Street is the only street closed entirely. This name is being revoked so that it may be reused in a new location.
