EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

I REVOKE Instrument DI2002-134 notified in the ACT Legislation Register on 4 July 2002.

I DETERMINE the street names in the Division of Dunlop as specified in the attached schedule and as indicated on the attached plan.

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the ACT Legislation Register, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the *Administration Act 1989*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Executive Director, Planning and Land Management, Department of Urban Services.

Section 27 of the *Interpretation Act 1967* specifies that where an Act confers a power on a person to make an instrument then, unless the contrary intention appears, that person has the further power to revoke the instrument.
