### **DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT DI2002-153**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

##### **Overview**

Regulation 75A (2) of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority who may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport Authority guidelines.

A.C.T. Strata Management Services who manages McKay Gardens Professional Centre and 28 Challis Street has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority within Block 3, Section 45 in the suburb of Turner and Block 24 Section 32 in the suburb of Dickson.

##### **Detail**

The object of this instrument is for the Road Transport Authority to declare A.C.T. Strata Management Services (McKay Gardens Professional Centre Turner and 28 Challis Street Dickson) as a Parking Authority, which enables the organisation to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme within its boundaries.
