EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 12 (4) of the Housing Assistance Act 1987 (the Act) provides for the Commissioner for Housing to revoke a program, however following approval by the Minister in accordance with section 12 (5). Section 12(5) provides for the Minister to approve a program or an amendment or revocation of a program.

The following Programs established under the Act and associated Disallowable Instruments [as outlined in detail in the Disallowable Instrument] are revoked:

- Concessional Home Loans Program
- Crisis Accommodation Housing Assistance Program
- Homesafe Housing Program
- Kickstart Housing Assistance Program
- Local Government and Community Housing Program
- Long Stay Caravan Park Program
- Providing or Assisting in Providing Dwelling Program
- Rent Relief Housing Assistance Program
- Short Term Lodging Housing Assistance Program
- Single Share Accommodation Scheme Program
- Supported Accommodation Assistance Program

The following Programs remain current, however there is a need for several Instruments under these Programs to be revoked as they are redundant:

- Public Rental Housing Assistance Program
- Rental Bonds Housing Assistance Program

The HomeBuyer Housing Assistance Program and the Community Organisation Rental Housing Assistance Program remain current and do not require any revocation of associated Instruments at this time.
