Road Transport (General) (Numberplate Fees) Determination 2006 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2006–117

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows for the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT Road Transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for transactions relating to vehicle numberplates and the rights to registration numbers issued under the *Road Transport Legislation*.

All numberplate fees have been increased by the Labour Price Index, rounded down to the nearest whole dollar for amounts over \$100 and the nearest multiple of 50c for amounts below \$100.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
