EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 93 of the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* specifies that the Minister must determine minimum fares, or ways of calculating minimum fares, payable by passengers for a demand responsive service. A determination under section 93 is a disallowable instrument.

This determination sets out the minimum fares for ACTION's flexibus service. The flexibus service is an evening demand responsive service where the driver plans the route depending on where the passengers want to go within a defined area.

The fares for the flexibus service are the same as the fares applying to ACTION regular routes services from 3 July 2006. The fares include student and concession fares. ACTION transfer tickets may be used when transferring from a regular route service to a flexibus service within the specified 90 minute period.

This Instrument commences on 3 July 2006.
