First Home Owner Grant (Objection Fees) Determination 2006 (No 1)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *First Home Owner Grant Act 2000* (the Act) enables eligible applicants purchasing a first home on or after 1 July 2000 to receive a first home owner grant. The Commissioner for ACT Revenue administers the Act.

Section 25 of the Act allows an applicant, who is dissatisfied in any way with a decision by the Commissioner relating to an application for a first home owner grant, to provide a written objection to the Commissioner.

Under section 54 of the Act, the Minister may determine, in writing, fees for the Act.

This determination sets the fee to accompany an objection under section 25 of the Act at \$64 per objection application.

This determination commences on 1 July 2006.
