EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, published in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to Part 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

This Instrument determines the names of six roads in the district of Jerrabomberra and one road in the district of Majura as specified in the attached schedule and associated plan. The intention is to gazette road names that have been signposted for many years, but for which there is no record of any previous gazettal action. This is part of the Authority's ongoing process of reviewing historic records and assigning a legal status to roads and streets where appropriate.

The number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years, and whether the names of women are well-represented, have been considered as required by the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.
