

Road Transport (General) (Vehicle Registration and Related Fees) Determination 2006 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2006–253

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* authorises for the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for vehicle registration and related transactions carried out under the road transport legislation.

The reason for this determination is to introduce three new fees and to increase two existing fees.

The new fees are for:

- the two-day course provided to Authorised Examiner Scheme applicants, \$250 (item 107);
- a basic vehicle identity check, \$37 (item 105); and
- a complex vehicle identity inspection, \$400 (item 106).

The increases are:

- the fee for heavy vehicle inspection fees, from \$74.50 to \$110 for trucks and from \$37 to \$67 for trailers (items 102 and 103).

All other fees are unchanged.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within six sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
