Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Venues) Determination 2007 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2007-98

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001 (the Act) regulates the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This instrument revokes determination DI2006-221 dated 18 October 2006 and notified under the Legislation Register on 19 October 2006. The determination approves the ACTTAB Limited Agencies as approved sports bookmaking venues.

The determination has been amended to reflect a change in location for the Dickson ACTTAB Agency from 24 Antill Street, Dickson ACT, to Unit 3, 20 Challis Street, Dickson ACT.

In all other respects the Instrument has not been altered.
