Gas Safety (Fees) Determination 2007 (No 1)

Gas Safety Act 2000, s67 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Gas Safety Act 2000* is an Act about safety in relation to the use of gas, and for other purposes.

Section 67 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2002 - 186 that set fees for the first time under the gas appliance worker accreditation scheme. That scheme came into effect from 1 January 2003 and fees have not since been varied. This determination therefore determines fees for the 2007-2008 financial year.

The fees take effect on the day after notification.

The determination under section 67 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
