Road Transport (General) (Vehicle Registration and Related Fees) Determination 2007 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2007– 175

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* authorises the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for vehicle registration and related transactions carried out under the road transport legislation.

Vehicle registration fees have been increased by the Wage Price Index of 4%, rounded down to the nearest whole dollar for amounts over \$100 and rounded down to the nearest 10c for amounts below \$100.

Heavy vehicle registration fees have been increased by 3.5% in line with in line with fees set by the National Transport Commission and the Commonwealth Government

There has been no increase in the Road Rescue Fee, the Short-term registration fee or the late transfer fee.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
