University of Canberra (Election of Council Members by Graduates) Repeal Statute 2007

Explanatory statement

Section 40 of the *University of Canberra Act 1989* gives the University Council the power to make Statutes.

Changes to the Act which came into effect on 19 December 2006 included changes to the membership of Council, removing the position of member elected by the graduates of the University of Canberra and its predecessor, the Canberra College of Advanced Education.

Section 42 of the University of Canberra Act 1989 requires that a Statute, once made by Council, be submitted by the Chancellor to the Executive for approval.
