

# UNIVERSITY OF CANBERRA (UNIVERSITY SEAL) STATUTE 2007

## Explanatory Statement

The *University of Canberra University Seal Statute 1992* provided that the affixing of the University seal be attested by the Chancellor or the Vice-Chancellor and the Secretary. The Council of the University has agreed that the testamurs of the University should bear the signatures of the Chancellor and the Vice-Chancellor instead of the Vice-Chancellor and the Secretary of Council. To facilitate this, the *University of Canberra University Seal Statute 1992* is repealed and replaced by the *University of Canberra (University Seal) Statute 2007*. The *University of Canberra (University Seal Statute) 2007* provides that the affixing of the University seal can be attested to by any two of the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor and the Secretary.
