EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Utilities Act 2000* (the Act), at section 22, provides that the Minister may, by the making of a disallowable instrument, exempt a person from the requirement for a licence in relation to provision of a utility service. The instrument of exemption may include compliance conditions to which the exemption is subject.

This instrument grants Active Utilities Pty Ltd, as an electricity supplier, an exemption from the licensing regime set out under s22 of the Act on the basis that Active Utilities Pty Ltd is to comply with specific conditions in providing electricity supplies on behalf of Direct Factory Outlet Canberra Pty Ltd.
