DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT: DI2007 - 307

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This determination sets out the maximum fares for ACTION's regular route services. This instrument includes:

- (a) people who use a bike rack on one of ACTION's buses. These people are entitled to travel for free.
- (b) people who are entitled to concession fares. Adding to persons who are Concession Card Holders include:
 - a person who is an ACT resident, has attained the age of 60 years and is the holder of an ACT Seniors Card.

The maximum fare amounts remain unchanged.

The instrument is also updated to comply with the *Legislation Act 2001* requirement that determinations must stipulate to whom, and by whom, fees must be paid.

This instrument commences 29 October 2007.
