EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* is an Act to regulate construction occupations, and for other purposes.

Section 127 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2007 - 147 that set fees for the 2007-08 financial year and to determine fees for the 2008-09 financial year.

The fees determined for the 2008-09 financial year represent the 2007-08 financial year fees increased in accordance with the Consumer Price Index March 2008 quarter annualised estimate of 4.2%. Appropriate rounding has occurred in relation to the increases.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2008.

The determination under section 127 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
